## GIT (White Card) Course Information Leaflet

### Description

This course requires the ability to demonstrate personal awareness of Work Health & Safety (WHS) legislative requirements, and the basic principles of risk management and prevention of injury and illness in the construction industry.

This White Card course covers the basic WHS knowledge required prior to commencing work tasks within any of the sectors of the construction industry.

### Entry requirements

There are no formal academic requirements for this qualification, however:

- Students must be 14 years of age prior to commencing the course.
- Students must provide 100 points of ID on the day of the course

All learning materials are provided.

For school aged students there are no fees for students in this course.
